

The Lynaberack Peatland Restoration Project is a multi-year project, with the objective of restoring over 110ha. of eroding blanket bog. The project will assist in reducing organic sediment load in the Spey catchment, reverse carbon loss through oxidation and erosion and improve the blanket bog habitat and improve biodiversity.

A number of techniques were employed including reprofiling eroded gullies and areas of micro-erosion, the installation of stone dams, the use of mulch filled hessian bales, sphagnum clump planting and the cutting and spreading of sphagnum rich mulch.
